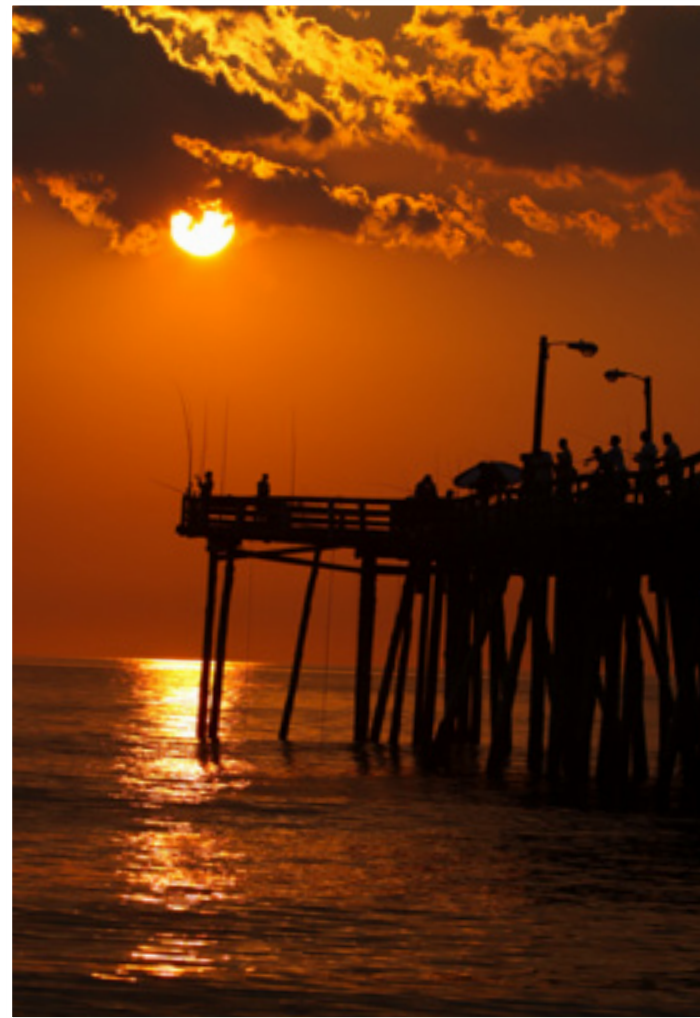

The Avalon Fishing Pier is 696 feet long. The water depth varies with the tides and storms, but the depth at the end of the pier normally ranges from twelve to fifteen feet.

The pier house sells bloodworms, squid, mullet, shrimp, and artificial lures, plus they have pool tables and video games.

Parking is limited and only pier customers may use the parking lot; however, you can park for free at any of the nearby public beach accesses.

The Avon Fishing Pier is a 600-foot-long pier on Hatteras Island that is great fun for the entire family.

Anglers can find all the fishing provisions they will need for a day on the pier including bait, tackle, ice, coolers, snacks, and cold beverages. The pier house also offers gifts and souvenirs. Parking is free.

Jennette's Pier is 1,000 feet long with concrete pilings. The pier house offers fishing equipment rentals, plus you can purchase bait, ice, and coolers. Keep in mind that the rod limit is two per angler and three for pin-rig fishing.

The pier holds fishing classes that focus on subjects such as how to jig or how to clean and cook your fresh catch. For young anglers, the pier offers morning or afternoon activities. Visit their website for program schedules.

The Kitty Hawk Pier, owned by the Hilton Garden Inn, offers fishing passes to the public.

The pier house is a 2,200-square-foot space that hosts weddings and other events, but it is not open to the public. So, because there is no tackle, bait, food, or beverages available in the pier house, visit a tackle shop and pack your cooler before you go.

Please park on the north side of the Hilton.



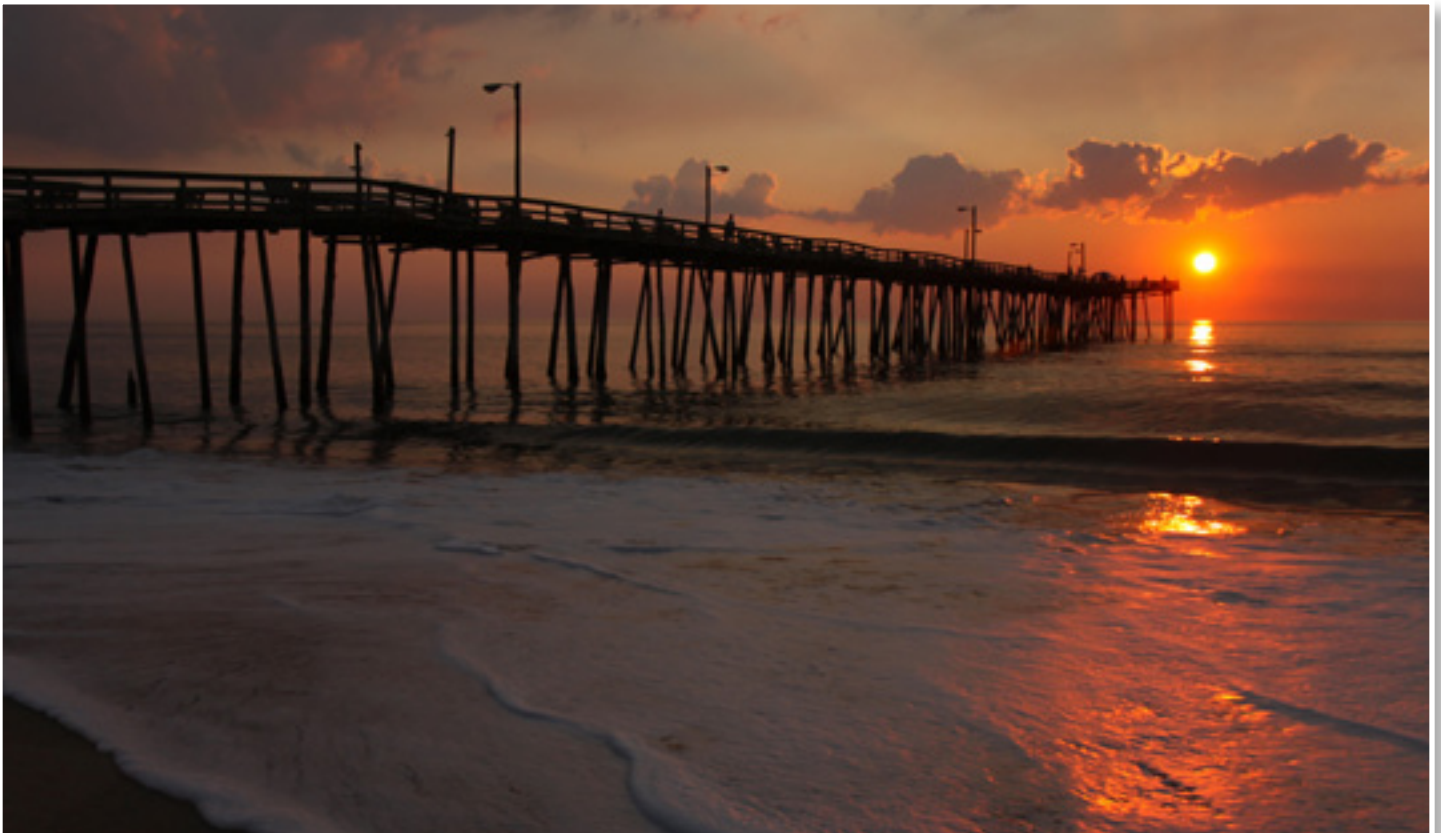

In addition, the pier house provides a gameroom where you can play video games, watch TV, and eat a snack.
